BYF-Boykins Fundamental Football League: Texas LoneStars (BYF-BFFL)

This is an adult, ages 18 years old and older, Amateur Football (Cheer and Dance) Team. (Winter/ Spring/ Summer). The kick-off season begins February, 2013, with a 15+ games schedule over a five-month period. The team’s objective is to promote the fundamentals of football in an environment that encourages extracurricular activities within our community and mentor the youth of the BYF and the surrounding community and to provide the young adults another opportunity to obtain their college education. The team make-up will involve an active roster of 65 players along with cheerleaders/dancers, coaches, and other staff members.



With ten home games and five+ away games, the BFFL-Texas Lonestars plan to produce radio/internet broadcasts of each game hosted. During these transmissions, our sponsored partners will be given advertisement slots to further promote their organization allowing exposure to their marketing campaign. Our goal within our team is to create another opportunity for companies to prove the philanthropic participation in the community. With each sponsor organization, BFFL will establish a bridge between company and community recognition for the potential target groups.

The BFFL will travel around the country for away games. This means your organization is given another option to promote from city to city. Company sponsored team T-shirts, with your organization’s logo, is another opportunity to create name branding on a national level.
